Time: 10.00 am to 4.00 pm

Adrian is a Post-Doctoral Research Assistant in the Department of Archaeological, Geographical and Environmental Sciences at the University of Bradford. He will be talking on lithic raw materials, technology and typology and there will be an opportunity for hands on learning of raw materials and types. There will also be a session on identifying the lithics in the Bordley collection.

The workshop is free. Refreshments are provided but lunch is not included. Participants are welcome to bring packed lunches as there is no shop in the village. The Angel Inn is located a few doors down but booking is essential (<http://www.angelhetton.co.uk/>).

Hetton is between Skipton and Grassington. Turn left off this road at Rylstone (before the duck pond), under the bridge to the 'T' junction. Turn left and through the village passing the Angel Inn on the right. The Methodist Church is a few houses further down on the right. Parking is available on the street only. Head up the path towards the main church door and follow round to the left, entering the door at the back.
